On Tuesday, April 19, DuPage Water Commission Water Preservation Group Member, Jenessa Nesbitt, was in attendance as an exhibitor for the DuPage County Earth Celebration Event. This was the second year that DuPage County hosted this event and was for DuPage County employees to learn how easy it is to 'Go Green'.

There were around 20 booths present with giveaways such as reusable totes, 'green' mugs, and tons of educational handouts on recycling, rain gardens, and much more. There were a few recycling games that employees could play and win preferred parking for a week, department store gift cards, etc.

DWC's dual flush toilet and DuPage County Stormwater Management Division's rain barrel were present. Around 80 informational pamphlets about toilet leaks, lawncare, indoor/outdoor water use, and a water quiz were handed out. About 50 5-minute shower timers, 80 rain gauges, and 150 toilet leak detection tablets were distributed.
