## EMPLOYMENT SOLICITATION Maintenance Technician

The DuPage Water Commission, operator of the second largest waterworks system in Illinois, is seeking two (2) full-time, experienced Maintenance Technicians to perform varied tasks as needed to support the Pipeline and Remote Facilities Department and the water distribution system throughout DuPage County. This position's shift is typically 6:30 AM to 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday, however occasional overtime may be required. This is a non-exempt position.

The qualified candidate for the Maintenance Technician shall possess a High School diploma or equivalent and a technical/trade school degree/certificate or have equivalent technical skills and experience; a minimum of 3 years of experience in water system maintenance, procedures, and practice or 3 years of experience in the area of general building maintenance, and use of basic Microsoft applications. An equivalent comparable amount of training, education or experience will be considered. Some heavy lifting and working in all weather conditions is required. Candidate should also be able to work at heights and be able to perform work in confined spaces. Knowledge and skill in underground utility locating is preferred, but not required.

The qualified candidate must possess a valid Illinois driver's license.

Starting salary will depend on qualifications and experience.
